


Lot 2 SAS/BAR QH PRINCE F200


GB/SAS BITTEN F634

- Tips for additional profits!! -

I love delivering bulls and also stopping in throughout the year to see how the cattle work out. It is mostly for me to learn things and get to know our customers.

BIF reported this year that weaning weights have been stagnant for the last 10 years, yet the amount of creep feed sold has increased exponentially recently.

There are three ways to increase weaning weights that I have come to realize that do not include buying commercial creep feed.

1: When rotational grazing raise the dividing fences so the calves can graze ahead into the next pasture, not the last. It's surprising how fast they learn this. This way the calves get the choice stuff before the cows come in. It increases weaning weights economically but not nearly as much as the dry hay. That lush grass doesn't have a lot of TDN, consequently a lot of the lush grass carries on through their stomach.

2: Creep feed with your own high quality hay. Green, fine hay is as appealing to any calf as purchased creep feed. Put it in a round bale feeder and use a hot wire to keep out the cows and let the calves in. Or spend an hour with your welder and make a creep gate that you can chain between an existing gate and corner post. I saw one made out of broken off steel posts that worked great. Hay gives them the perfect conditioning for maximum selling prices and makes weaning super easy and efficient. This one will give you as much extra weaning weight as any creep feed without getting the heifers too fat.

3: Buy Springer Simmental genetics. We concentrate on cattle that thrive on grass and select for as much weaning and yearling weight as possible without too much frame.
